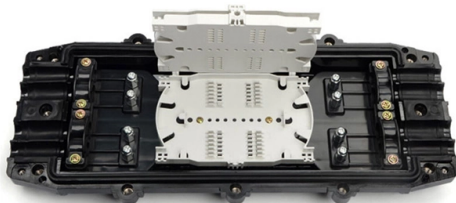

1. Tray Type and Material Choose a tray suitable for light loads and indoor use. Ventilated or wire-mesh trays are ideal for countertops as they allow airflow and prevent heat buildup from electronics . Aluminum or light-gauge steel trays are preferred for corrosion resistance and ease of handling . 2. Load Capacity and Support Even on a countertop, the tray must not exceed its maximum load rating. Standard trays can support 318–340 kg per hanger with spacing up to 3.6 m . For a countertop, shorter spans and additional supports (like brackets or clamps) are recommended to prevent sagging or damage. 3. Mounting and Securing

- Use brackets or clamps fixed to the countertop edge or wall to secure the tray.
- Avoid using the tray itself as a structural support for heavy objects.
- Ensure the tray is level and stable to prevent cables from sliding or bending beyond their minimum radius . 4. Cable Management
- Maintain proper spacing between rungs (150–230 mm) to support cables and prevent tangling .

- Keep cables organized and avoid overloading the tray.
- For sensitive electronics, consider a solid or covered tray to protect against dust or accidental spills .
- 5. Safety and Compliance
- Installation should follow standard electrical practices and local codes .
- Do not use the tray as a ladder or step.
- Ensure all fasteners are secure and that the tray does not interfere with countertop use or appliances .

Practical Tips

- For short countertop runs, use multiple small trays rather than one long tray to simplify installation.
- Consider removable covers for easy access to cables.
- If the countertop is made of wood or composite, use appropriate anchors or inserts to prevent cracking or loosening over time.
