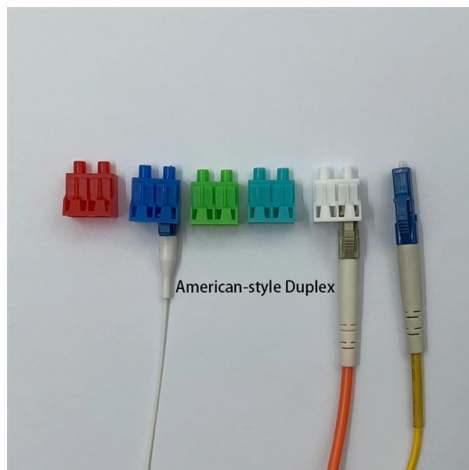

Is Repair Possible?

All major sources agree that cut fiber optic cables are fully repairable. Unlike copper cables, fiber cannot be fixed with tape or simple connectors — it requires specialized tools and precise splicing techniques.

How Fiber Optic Cables Are Repaired

1. Locate the Break

Common tools include:

- VFL (Visual Fault Locator): Shows red light leakage at the break.
- OTDR: Measures reflections to pinpoint the break within ± 1 m, essential for long or buried cables.

2. Prepare the Cable

Steps typically include:

- Trim damaged ends with fiber cutters.

- Strip the protective coating using fiber strippers.
 - Clean and cleave the fiber ends for a smooth splice.
