A distribution box is primarily designed to house circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, and terminal blocks for distributing electricity safely across circuits . It focuses on electrical safety, structured wiring, and protection, and typically does not include socket outlets. Installing a socket directly in a standard distribution box is generally not recommended, as it can compromise safety, violate electrical codes, and reduce accessibility for maintenance . In contrast, a socket combination box is specifically designed to integrate both socket outlets and protective components in a single enclosure. These boxes come in empty, pre-assembled, or fully assembled versions, with proper wiring, DIN rails, and protective devices already configured for safe socket use . Using a combination box ensures compliance with safety standards while providing convenient access to power outlets.

Safety and Regulatory Considerations

- **Electrical Codes:** According to NEC and other standards, panelboards and distribution boxes must maintain clear working space and accessibility. Adding sockets inside a standard distribution box could violate clearance and dedicated space requirements .
 - **Protection Devices:** Each socket should have its own protection (breaker or fuse) to prevent overloads. Standard distribution boxes may not provide this for added sockets .
 - **Mounting and Accessibility:** Sockets must be mounted at safe heights (typically 450–1200 mm from the floor) to avoid mechanical damage or wetting . Distribution boxes are often mounted higher, making direct socket use impractical.
- Practical Recommendation

If you need a socket near a distribution panel:

- Use a combination box designed for sockets and protective components .
- Install a separate socket outlet nearby, fed from a dedicated circuit in the distribution box.
- Ensure compliance with local electrical codes, proper grounding, and protection devices . This approach maintains safety, accessibility, and code compliance while providing the convenience of a nearby socket.
