What It Means

When secondary distribution boxes (or transformers) are connected in parallel, their outputs are linked to a common bus or collector bus. This setup allows all connected transformers to supply power to the same load simultaneously, rather than each transformer serving a separate load independently. The voltage across the secondary bus remains constant, while the total current supplied is the sum of the currents from each transformer or feeder. This is similar to connecting power supplies in parallel to increase current capacity without changing voltage.

- Load Sharing: Each transformer contributes to the total load, preventing any single transformer from being overloaded.

- **High Reliability:** If one transformer or feeder fails, the remaining units continue to supply power, minimizing service interruptions . This is particularly important in high-density areas, hospitals, or commercial centers.

How It Works

- **Paralleling Bus:** The secondary outputs of multiple transformers are connected to a common bus. This bus distributes power to the loads.
- **Network Protectors:** Devices with reverse power relays prevent backflow of current into a transformer that is offline or under fault conditions .
- **Load Continuity:** In normal operation, all transformers feed the bus. If one primary feeder fails, the others maintain supply, ensuring continuous service .
