Central Asia's electricity network spans Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan, historically interconnected through a Soviet-era unified grid. This system included 500 kV transmission lines forming a ring, which allowed parallel operation and improved reliability even if individual links failed. After the Soviet Union dissolved, centralized coordination and resource distribution ceased, leading to fragmented national grids and uneven electricity access. Efforts are underway to reestablish a Central Asian Power System (CAPS) to reconnect all five states and enable coordinated generation and distribution.

Generation and Energy Mix



The region's electricity generation is dominated by fossil fuels, particularly coal and natural gas, which account for roughly 75% of production . Hydropower is significant in Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan, while Uzbekistan is expanding solar and high-efficiency gas plants to diversify its energy mix . Modernization projects include battery storage systems and large-scale solar installations, such as the 890 MW of solar capacity in Uzbekistan, which improve grid stability and supply reliability .

Distribution Challenges

Power distribution in Central Asia faces several structural and technical challenges:

- Rural and mountainous areas often experience intermittent supply due to weak grid connectivity and seasonal mismatches between hydropower generation and demand .
- Aging infrastructure: Up to 70% of networks and thermal plants require modernization, leading to frequent outages and inefficiencies .
- Institutional fragmentation: Divergent national priorities, subsidy regimes, and limited cross-border coordination distort electricity allocation and pricing .
- Seasonal variability: Hydropower-dependent regions face shortages in winter, while thermal plants struggle with fuel supply and maintenance .

Modernization and Regional Coordination

To address these issues, Central Asian countries are pursuing:

- Grid modernization and digitalization, including smart meters and AI-assisted load management .
- Renewable integration, leveraging solar, wind, and hydropower potential to reduce reliance on fossil fuels and improve sustainability .
- Regional cooperation, through CAPS and interstate power commissions, to optimize generation, reduce systemic risks, and enable cross-border electricity trade .
- Investment in distributed generation, particularly for remote communities, to ensure equitable access and reduce transmission losses .

Outlook

With electricity demand projected to increase by up to 40% by 2030, Central Asia is focusing on a “middle path” strategy: modernizing traditional generation, gradually expanding renewables, implementing energy storage, and restoring regional integration . These measures aim to provide reliable, affordable, and sustainable electricity, while supporting economic growth and energy security across the region.
