When switches are connected in series, the current flows sequentially through each switch. If any switch in the series is turned off, the circuit is broken and the connected load will not operate. This setup is often used for safety interlocks or to ensure multiple conditions are met before a device operates. For example, in a series connection of two switches controlling a light, both switches must be on for the light to illuminate.

Series Switches in a Distribution Box

In a distribution box, switches such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) or isolators are typically used to control and protect individual circuits. Connecting these switches in series is uncommon for standard load distribution because:

- Voltage drop: Each switch introduces a small voltage drop, which can reduce the voltage available to the load if multiple switches are in series.

- **Load control:** Series connections mean that turning off any one switch will cut power to all downstream loads, which may not be desirable in domestic or commercial installations .
- **Safety and protection:** Series connections can be used intentionally for interlocks or sequential control, but care must be taken to ensure that protective devices like MCBs and RCCBs are rated correctly and coordinated .

Practical Considerations

- **Main MCB and RCCB:** In a single-phase distribution box, the main MCB receives the input supply, and its output is connected to an RCCB for protection. The output of the RCCB then feeds individual load MCBs .
- **Series use cases:** Series connections are mainly used for control circuits or safety switches, not for general load distribution. For example, two safety switches in series can ensure a machine only operates when both switches are closed .
- **Neutral and earth connections:** Even in series switch setups, the neutral and earth connections must be properly distributed to all loads to maintain safety and compliance with standards .
- **Limit on number of series switches:** Too many switches in series can reduce voltage to the load and may cause operational issues, so the number of series-connected switches should be limited .
