A cold aisle system is a thermal containment strategy where the front faces of electrical or IT equipment racks are aligned to form a “cold aisle” that receives cooled air, while the backs of the racks form a “hot aisle” for exhaust air. This separation prevents mixing of hot and cold air, ensuring that equipment receives consistent cooling and reducing the risk of overheating .

- Containment Panels and Roofs: Panels or strips create a physical barrier to isolate cold air in the aisle. Roof panels can be fixed, openable, or functional to accommodate environmental control modules and fire suppression systems .
- Doors: Sliding or swinging doors with clear panels allow controlled access while maintaining airflow separation. Dual mechanical doors enhance safety and security .

- **Modular Frame:** Cold aisle systems are often modular, allowing easy installation, scalability, and future expansion. Frames are typically made of cold-rolled steel for durability .

- **Environmental Monitoring:** Sensors for temperature, humidity, and airflow can be integrated to optimize cooling efficiency and provide real-time monitoring .

Design Considerations

- **Rack Alignment:** Cabinets must be arranged in a hot aisle/cold aisle layout. Cold air is supplied through perforated floor tiles or in-row cooling units directly to the cold aisle .

- **Airflow Management:** Proper sealing of panels, roof, and doors ensures that cold air is directed to the equipment intake and hot air is returned to cooling units without bypassing or mixing .

- **Fire Safety:** Openable roof panels or electro-magnetically controlled panels allow fire suppression systems to operate effectively without compromising containment .

- **Customization:** Systems can be tailored to room dimensions, rack heights, and cooling requirements. Standard solutions typically support 42U-52U cabinets, but custom configurations are available .
