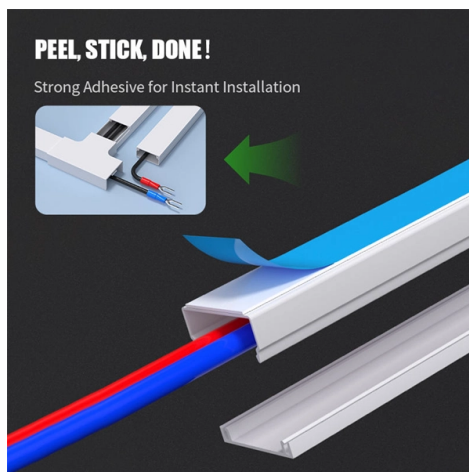


Connecting boxes on railways

TCB's will generally sit between the 110V transformer and equipment, allowing for a local point of disconnection in the event of a failure or maintenance.
