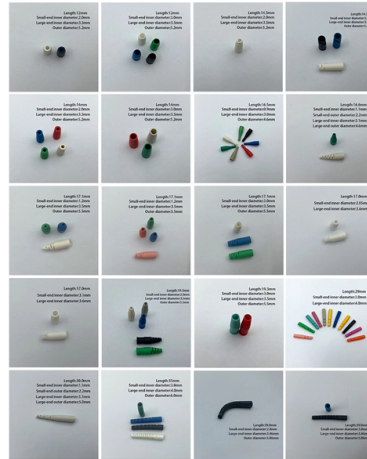

- **Wavelength and Bandwidth:** Ensure the coupler supports the operating wavelength of your system (commonly 1310 nm or 1550 nm for long-distance SM fibers). Fusion couplers have narrower bandwidth, while PLC and micro-optic couplers support broader ranges.
- **Polarization and Environmental Stability:** For sensitive applications, consider polarization-maintaining (PM) couplers or micro-optic designs with high thermal stability to reduce polarization-dependent loss over long distances.
- **Connectors and Integration:** Use compatible connectors (e.g., LC, SC) to interface with your fiber. LC adapters are commonly used for SM fibers and can extend or connect optical cables efficiently.

Recommendation

For a 3000-meter single-mode fiber, a fusion coupler is generally the best choice due to its low insertion loss and high reliability. If multiple outputs or compact integration is required, a PLC coupler can be considered, keeping in mind slightly higher loss. Ensure the coupler is rated for your operating wavelength and fiber type to maintain signal quality over the long distance.
