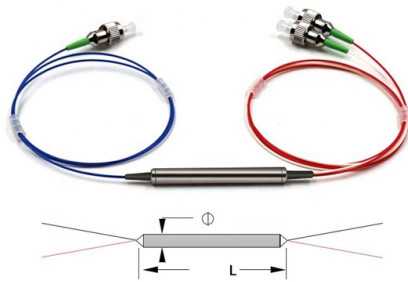

- Bending or Thermal Switches: Alter the refractive index of waveguides using localized heating to redirect light, often used in integrated photonics .

- All-Optical Switches: Operate entirely in the optical domain without converting signals to electrical form, reducing latency and power consumption, and are increasingly used in data centers and 5G/6G networks .

Applications

- Telecommunications: Dynamic routing, protection switching, and ROADM networks .

- Data Centers: High-speed optical interconnects and cloud infrastructure .

- Laser Systems: Pulse picking, Q-switching, and beam control .

- Quantum Networking: Routing single photons with minimal loss .

- Test and Measurement: Automating connections between devices under test .
