- **Wire Size:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically required, while in other markets a 6 mm² wire is standard . For connections between mounting plates and spindles, larger wires (e.g., 16 mm² or 6 AWG) may be used to maintain low resistance over long cable runs .
- **Resistance Limits:** The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensure effective fault current dissipation .

- **Bonding:** All metallic components, including enclosures, raceways, and equipment, should be bonded into a continuous grounding system to maintain equal potential and prevent dangerous voltage differences .

Installation Practices

- **Connection Points:** Ground wires should be attached from threaded studs on the distribution box to the mounting plate, and then from the mounting plate to the central grounding point .
- **Material Selection:** Copper conductors are preferred for buried runs, as aluminum can degrade over time . Certified materials from reputable suppliers ensure long-term reliability.
- **Testing:** Regular testing of ground resistance and continuity is essential to verify performance and identify any weak points .
