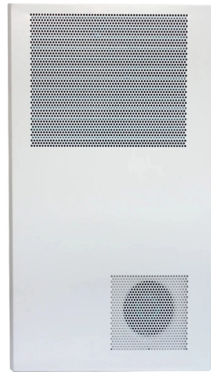


Does fiber optic cable use a regular router

Fiber optic internet transmits data as pulses of light through thin glass or plastic fibers, offering extremely high speeds and low latency compared to traditional copper connections. However, standard home routers are designed to handle electrical signals over Ethernet, not optical signals. Therefore, a direct connection from a fiber cable to a regular router is not possible.

Role of the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

The ONT, usually provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP), serves as the bridge between the fiber network and your home network. Its main functions include:

- Optoelectronic conversion: Converts incoming light signals from the fiber into electrical signals compatible with routers and computers.
- Connection interface: Provides standard Ethernet ports (usually labeled LAN or WAN) for connecting your router.

- Signal management: Ensures stable and reliable data transmission from the fiber network to your home devices.

Connecting Your Router

Once the ONT is installed:

- Use an Ethernet cable: Connect one end to the ONT's Ethernet port and the other to your router's WAN port .
- Power on devices: Turn on the ONT first, wait for the status lights to stabilize, then power on your router.
- Verify connection: Check that your router indicates an active internet connection and that devices can access the network.

Fiber-Ready Routers

Some routers have built-in SFP or fiber ports, allowing direct fiber connections without a separate ONT. These are typically high-end or enterprise-grade models. For most residential setups, a standard router will require the ONT to interface with the fiber network .
