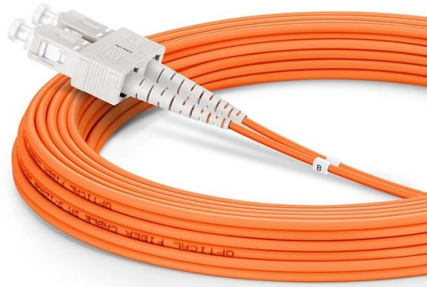

Main Components

- Enclosure: The outer shell protects internal components from dust, water, and mechanical damage. It is usually made of steel or plastic and rated according to IP or NEMA standards for indoor or outdoor use ().
- Main Breaker: Serves as the primary disconnect and overcurrent protection for the entire panel ().
- Branch Circuit Breakers: Individual breakers for each circuit, typically ranging from 4 to 12 or more depending on the load and panel size ().
- Bus Bars: Conductive bars that distribute power from the main breaker to branch breakers. Includes both phase bus bars and neutral bus bars ().

- Site Assessment: Verify indoor/outdoor placement, accessibility, and compliance with local codes ().
- Material Inspection: Check all components against approved specifications before installation ().
- Mounting: Secure the enclosure at the recommended height (typically 1–1.8 meters for residential, industrial may vary) with adequate clearance ().
- Internal Assembly: Install bus bars, breakers, neutral and ground bars, and other accessories according to manufacturer instructions ().
- Wiring: Route and secure conductors, connect breakers, and ensure proper grounding ().
- Testing: Perform visual inspection and multimeter tests before energizing the system ().
