Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or breaker panel, is the central hub of an electrical system. It receives the main power supply and divides it into multiple branch circuits, each protected by circuit breakers, fuses, or residual current devices (RCDs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and earth faults. Distribution boxes are designed to handle higher voltages and currents, making them suitable for residential, commercial, and industrial applications. They often include monitoring features and allow isolation of individual circuits for maintenance without disrupting the entire system. Typical locations include basements, electrical rooms, or service areas where main circuits converge.

Junction Box



A junction box is an enclosure used primarily for connecting, branching, and protecting electrical wires. It does not distribute power or contain circuit breakers . Junction boxes provide a safe environment for wire splices, terminations, and cable connections, shielding them from dust, moisture, and accidental contact . They are generally smaller than distribution boxes and are used in ceilings, walls, attics, or along cable runs where wires need to be joined or redirected . Junction boxes are ideal for low-voltage or lower-current applications and ensure reliable electrical contact at connection points.

Choosing Between Them

- Use a distribution box when you need centralized control, protection, and distribution of electrical power to multiple circuits. It is essential for managing load, isolating faults, and enabling safe shutdowns across a building .
- Use a junction box for local wire connections where power distribution is not required. It organizes wiring paths, protects splices, and allows branching or rerouting of cables .
