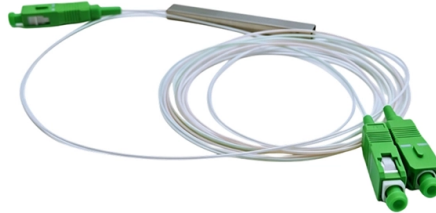


Fiber Optic Cable Connection Port

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts optical signals to electrical signals for your router .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable: Cat6 or Cat6a recommended for high-speed data transfer .

Step-by-Step Connection

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home .

- Power on the ONT: Wait 2–5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .
- Connect the ONT to your router: Use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port .
- Power on the router: Wait for indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .
- Access the router's admin panel: Enter the IP address (e.g., 192.168.1.1) and input ISP credentials if required .
- Test the connection: Use a device to check internet access and run a speed test to verify performance .

Best Practices

- Avoid bending the fiber cable beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss .
- Secure excess cable with velcro straps or cable managers to prevent tension or loops .
- Keep connectors clean and dust-free; use dust caps when not connected .
- Update router firmware to ensure optimal performance and security . By following these steps and handling the fiber carefully, you can achieve a stable, high-speed fiber optic connection for your home or office network .
