- Use condition-based maintenance rather than fixed schedules: monitor performance with OTDR, power meters, and other diagnostic tools .
- Protect cables with proper enclosures, conduits, and UV-resistant jackets in harsh environments .
- Plan for technological upgrades to ensure network capacity meets future demands .
