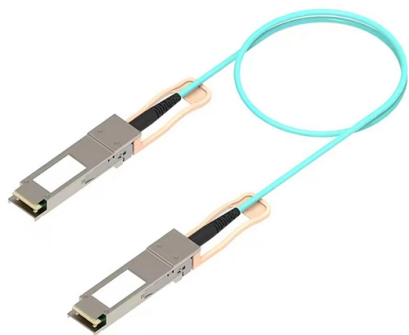

This design ensures that the fibers experience minimal strain, maintaining low optical loss over long distances. Single-mode fibers operating at 1310 nm or 1550 nm can achieve unrepeated spans of up to 100 km, and a single cable can carry up to 864 fibers.

Applications

ADSS cables are primarily used by power utilities and ISPs for aerial fiber deployment along transmission and distribution lines. They allow live-line installation, meaning the cable can be strung without shutting down power, which reduces installation costs and operational disruption. The cable's ability to span 50 m to over 1,500 m between towers makes it versatile for both urban and rural networks.
