Gigabit Ethernet (1 Gbps) ports on industrial switches are designed to handle high-bandwidth applications in manufacturing, transportation, utilities, and outdoor environments. These ports are available in RJ45 copper format for standard Ethernet cables and SFP slots for fiber optic modules, allowing flexible deployment over short or long distances . IP-rated enclosures (IP40-IP67) protect against dust and moisture, making them suitable for outdoor or harsh industrial environments .

Advanced Features

Managed Gigabit switches provide network segmentation, QoS, MAC limitation, port security, and SNMP monitoring . Some models include device-to-cloud performance monitoring and advanced security protocols like Cisco TrustSec for microsegmentation . Jumbo frame support (up to 9600 bytes) and automatic speed detection enhance performance and flexibility .
