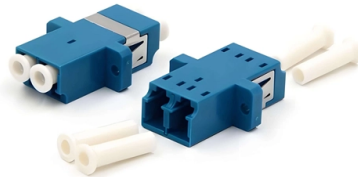

In a centralized distribution box, grounding is essential for equipment protection, system stability, and fault detection. The ground wire provides a safe path for fault currents and transient overvoltages, preventing damage to electrical components and reducing the risk of electrical fires or shocks. Proper grounding also stabilizes voltage levels, ensuring protective devices like circuit breakers operate correctly.

Wire Sizing and Connections

- **Wire Size:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard. For connections between mounting plates and equipment like spindles, larger wires (16 mm² or 6 AWG) may be required to maintain low resistance, especially for longer cable runs.
- **Connection Points:** Ground wires should be attached from threaded studs at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate, and then from the mounting plate to the factory central grounding point. This ensures all system parts have a ground resistance below 0.1 Ohm.

- **Central Grounding Box:** For multiple connections, a central grounding box or terminal strip can be used. These boxes allow up to seven grounding wires to be securely fastened, providing a robust and permanent connection, often used in ESD-sensitive environments .

Installation Considerations

- **Material Selection:** Use high-quality copper or copper-clad steel conductors to prevent corrosion and maintain low resistance over time . Avoid substandard materials that can degrade quickly.
- **Resistance Testing:** After installation, test the grounding system to ensure resistance is below recommended limits (typically
