- **Outdoor Installations:** Boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water and dirt .

- **Panelboard Limits:** The highest circuit breaker or disconnect switch should not exceed 2 meters (6 ft 7 in) above the floor to remain within code limits .
