A distribution box, also called a DB box, is an enclosure that safely distributes electrical power from a main supply to multiple circuits within a building, housing protective devices like circuit breakers, fuses, and busbars. The "positions" or "ways" in a distribution box refer to the slots available for installing these protective devices, which determine how many circuits the box can manage.

Typical Configurations

- Residential DB Boxes: Usually have 6, 8, 12, or 18 positions, sufficient for lighting, sockets, and small appliances.
- Commercial or Industrial DB Boxes: Can have 24, 30, or 36 positions, accommodating higher loads, machinery, or multiple sub-circuits.

- Single-phase vs Three-phase: Single-phase boxes generally have fewer positions, while three-phase boxes require more positions to handle multiple phases and higher current loads .

Factors Affecting the Number of Positions

- Number of Outgoing Circuits: The total number of circuits plus spare positions for future expansion.
- Protective Device Strategy: The type of breakers or fuses used (MCB, RCCB, RCBO) can influence how many positions are needed.
- Space and Layout: Busbar compatibility, neutral and earth bar arrangement, and cable entry space affect the practical number of positions .

Practical Considerations

Choosing a distribution box solely by the number of positions can be misleading. A smaller box with poor internal layout may be less effective than a larger, well-designed box with more positions and better busbar and cable management . Always consider future expansion, safety standards, and the type of installation when selecting a DB box. In summary, distribution boxes can have anywhere from 6 to 36 positions or more, with the exact number depending on the building's electrical requirements, type of installation, and protective device configuration .
