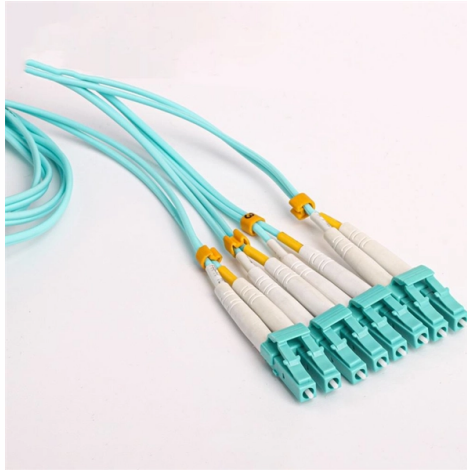

1. Environmental Protection: Choose a box rated for the installation environment. For outdoor or semi-outdoor deployments, an IP65 or higher rating ensures protection against dust and water ingress, while UV-stable materials and gasketed doors enhance durability (). Indoor boxes may prioritize fire-resistant materials and compact designs for data centers or closets ().
2. Fiber Compatibility: Ensure the box supports the fiber types in your network, whether single-mode, multi-mode, or ribbon fibers. Check that the splice trays and adapter panels match your connector types (SC, LC, etc.) to maintain organization and prevent signal loss ().
3. Splicing Method: For high-performance networks, fusion splicing is preferred due to its low signal loss ().
