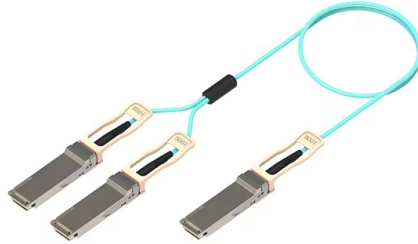

Step 4: Insert the Fiber Optic Module

Align the module with the port and gently insert it until it clicks or locks into place. Do not force the module, as excessive pressure can damage the port or the module itself . For threaded FC connectors, rotate the screw to secure the connection.

Step 5: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable

Insert the fiber optic cable into the module, ensuring the connector is clean and free of dust. Use a dust cap until ready to connect. Push the connector in until it clicks or locks, depending on the connector type . Maintain the minimum bend radius of the cable to prevent signal loss.

Step 6: Test the Connection

After connecting, verify the link using network testing tools such as visual fault locators or Optical Time Domain Reflectometers (OTDRs) to check for signal integrity and performance . Ensure both ends of the cable are properly aligned and secured.

Step 7: Manage Cables

Organize excess cable using velcro straps or cable managers to prevent tension, tight loops, or interference. Proper cable management extends the life of the fiber and maintains optimal signal quality . By following these steps—preparing tools, handling modules carefully, aligning connectors correctly, and testing the connection—you can ensure a reliable and high-performance fiber optic network .
