- **Circuit Breakers:** If your distribution box includes breakers, ensure each wire is connected to the correct breaker slot according to the intended load .
 - **Wire Gauge:** Use wires of appropriate thickness for the current load to prevent overheating .
 - **Labeling:** Mark each wire clearly to avoid confusion during future maintenance .
