Overhead optical fiber lines are installed using a structured process involving pole selection, cable type determination, route planning, tensioning, and adherence to technical standards to ensure durability and performance. 1. Planning and Site Survey

The first step is a site survey to assess the terrain, existing utility poles, obstacles, and environmental conditions. Engineers map the route, determine pole locations, and decide whether to use self-supporting or messenger-supported cables. The survey also identifies central distribution points and ensures compliance with local regulations and safety standards ().

2. Pole Selection and Installation

- Pole Type and Height: Standard poles are typically 7 meters high with a tip diameter of 150 mm. For special crossings (roads, rivers, railways), poles of 8–9 meters may be used ().
- Foundation Depth: Stone surfaces require 0.9 m depth, while other soils need 1.2 m ().
- Pole Spacing: Standard spacing is 50 m, adjustable to 60 m in mountainous areas. Extreme environments may require reinforced poles with spacing up to 67 m ().

- Alignment and Verticality: Poles must be vertical with minimal deviation (
