To connect a fiber optic cable to your router, you will need:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts the fiber's light signals into electrical signals compatible with your router .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable: Typically Cat6 or higher to link the ONT to your router .
- Compatible router: Ensure it has a WAN port or supports fiber input, sometimes via SFP modules .



- Power supply: For both the ONT and the router .

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT: Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters.

- Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and confirm the indicator lights show a successful connection .

- Router Configuration: Some routers may require configuration to recognize the fiber connection. Follow your router's setup instructions or your ISP's guidance.

- Optional Wi-Fi Expansion: For larger areas, mesh Wi-Fi devices can be added to extend coverage .

- Do not plug fiber directly into a standard router; the ONT is essential for signal conversion .

- Handle fiber connectors carefully: Avoid touching the glass tip to prevent damage or signal loss .

- Use high-quality Ethernet cables: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain gigabit speeds .

- Combo units: Some ISPs provide devices that combine the ONT and router in one unit, simplifying setup . By following these steps, your fiber optic connection will be properly converted and distributed through your router, providing high-speed, low-latency internet across your devices .
