Connect to the Grounding Rod: Drive a grounding rod into the earth near the distribution box. Connect the other end of the ground wire from the PE bar to the rod. Ensure a large contact area between the wire and rod for effective grounding . 5. Verify Ground Resistance: Use a voltmeter or ground resistance tester to measure the resistance between the distribution box and the earth. The resistance should be below 25 ohms for general installations, and in industrial setups, it may need to be below 0.1 ohm depending on system requirements . If resistance is too high, add additional rods or relocate the rod to achieve proper grounding. 6. Additional Considerations:

- Use the correct wire size: typically 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) in the US or 6 mm² elsewhere for the main ground connection .
- For systems with multiple spindles or long tool cables, consider parallel grounding wires to reduce total resistance .
- Ensure all metallic parts of the system are bonded to maintain equal potential and prevent dangerous voltage differences .
- Clearly mark grounding connections for inspection and maintenance . Following these steps ensures that the distribution box is safely grounded, protecting both equipment and personnel from electrical hazards.
