The main circuit breaker or main service disconnect is the primary switch that controls electricity to your entire home. It is usually located at the top of the main electrical panel, which can be found in accessible areas such as the basement, garage, or utility room . Flipping this breaker to the OFF position will cut power to all circuits in the house, providing a safe environment for maintenance or emergency situations . In older homes with a fuse box, the main disconnect may be a larger fuse or pull-out block that serves the same purpose .

Individual Circuit Disconnects
