Proper planning for installing cable tray includes calculations based on loading, support systems, cable/wire fill and spacing, conductor types, securing of the cables and wire, and proper grounding and bonding are all important aspects of cable tray installation. Proper installation of cables in trays is critical for maintaining an efficient and safe electrical system. For licensed electricians, mastering these principles is essential. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. Trays and fittings should be stacked by their physical dimensions (width) and type. All material finishes are prone to storage stain if they are improperly stored outdoors.
