- Never look directly into the fiber end, as it may emit invisible infrared light.
- Work slowly and with controlled movements to protect the glass fibers.
- Avoid bending the cable sharply; loose coils are acceptable.
- If connectors are recessed or corroded, seek professional assistance . Following these steps ensures that your fiber optic cable is safely unplugged without damaging the cable, connectors, or your home internet equipment.
