Install Protective Covers A solid or ventilated cover can shield the tray from direct rain or debris. Solid covers are particularly effective for horizontal trays exposed to the elements, while ventilated covers allow airflow but may require additional sealing at joints . 5. Regular Maintenance and Inspection Check drainage holes, sealants, and tray supports periodically. Remove debris, inspect for cracks or corrosion, and reapply sealants as needed to maintain waterproof performance . 6. Compliance with Standards Ensure the tray meets IP (Ingress Protection) ratings or other relevant waterproofing standards. Testing methods such as immersion, rain simulation, and high-pressure water jets can verify the tray's resistance to water ingress .
