Fiber optic internet uses an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert light signals into electrical signals for your network. Typically, your ISP provides a single ONT or a modem-router combo. To use multiple routers, the primary router connects directly to the ONT, while secondary routers connect to the primary router to extend the network or create separate segments .

Step-by-Step Configuration

- Connect the Primary Router
- Plug the fiber optic cable into the WAN port of your primary router.
- Power on the router and configure it with your ISP settings if required.
- Ensure the primary router is providing internet access to connected devices .

- Connect the Secondary Router
- Use an Ethernet cable to connect a LAN port on the primary router to the WAN port of the secondary router.
- Configure the secondary router in Access Point (AP) mode or Bridge Mode to avoid double NAT issues. If AP mode is unavailable, you can leave it in router mode but be aware of potential NAT conflicts .
- IP Address and DHCP Settings
- Assign a static IP to the secondary router within the same subnet as the primary router (e.g., primary: 192.168.1.1, secondary: 192.168.1.2).
- Disable DHCP on the secondary router to prevent IP conflicts, allowing the primary router to manage all IP assignments .
- Wi-Fi Configuration
- Set different SSIDs for each router for easy identification, or use the same SSID for seamless roaming.
- Choose non-overlapping Wi-Fi channels to reduce interference.
- Place routers strategically: the primary router centrally, and the secondary router where the signal is strong but coverage is needed .
- Testing and Optimization
- Test internet connectivity and speed in different areas.
- Adjust router placement, channels, and settings as needed to ensure stable coverage and performance .

Use Cases

- Extending Wi-Fi coverage in large homes or offices.
- Creating separate networks for gaming, IoT devices, or guest access.
- Adding additional wired connections for devices like PCs, NAS, or smart TVs.

Key Considerations

- Avoid connecting multiple routers directly to the ONT unless your ISP allows multiple IP addresses.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables (CAT5E or higher) for reliable connections.
- Keep router firmware updated to ensure compatibility and security.
- Consider mesh Wi-Fi systems if seamless coverage across multiple floors is a priority . By following these steps, you can efficiently set up multiple routers on a fiber optic connection, improving coverage, network segmentation, and overall performance.
