Fiber optic cables transmit data as light signals, which cannot be directly interpreted by standard routers. To use fiber internet, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your ISP to convert the optical signals into Ethernet signals that a router can handle. The router then manages your home network, providing Wi-Fi and wired connections to multiple devices.

Can You Connect Fiber Directly to a Router?

Only routers with a special SFP port designed for fiber input can connect directly to a fiber cable. Most home routers do not have this capability, so the ONT acts as an intermediary. The ONT connects to the router via an Ethernet cable, typically plugged into the router's WAN port.

Router Requirements for Fiber



While any router with a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port can technically work, to fully utilize fiber speeds, consider the following:

- WAN and LAN port speed: Ensure ports support your plan's maximum speed to avoid bottlenecks .
 - Wi-Fi standard: Wi-Fi 6 or 6E routers are recommended for high-speed, multi-device environments .
 - Processor and RAM: Higher-end routers handle high packet rates and complex routing efficiently .
 - Advanced features: Quality of Service (QoS) and mesh systems can optimize performance in large homes .
