

Is it okay to connect the power adapter to the optical module

- Prepare for Installation
 - Wear an anti-static wrist strap or other grounding device to prevent electrostatic discharge (ESD) damage to the module .
 - Place the module on an antistatic mat or foam if it is not yet installed .
- Insert the Optical Module
 - Identify the alignment key on the module and match it to the port keyway.
 - Slide the module straight into the port without twisting or forcing it. Apply firm, even pressure until it clicks or the latch engages .
 - If the module has a screw or bail latch, secure it snugly but do not overtighten .
- Prepare the Power Connection
 - Ensure the dust caps are removed from both the module's power interface and the adapter connector.

- Verify that the power adapter matches the module's specifications (voltage and current requirements) to avoid damage .
- Connect the Power Adapter
 - Align the adapter plug with the module's power interface.
 - Insert the adapter straight into the port until it is fully seated. Avoid rocking or twisting the connector .
 - Confirm that the connection is stable and secure.
- Power On and Configure
 - Turn on the power supply switch for the module.
 - Use the device's management interface or command line to set parameters such as working mode, speed, and power level .
 - The module will automatically start transmitting and receiving optical signals once powered.
- Verify Operation
 - Check the port status LED or diagnostic indicators to ensure the module is functioning correctly .
 - Monitor transmit and receive power levels and adjust if necessary.

Safety and Handling Tips

- Never touch the golden finger contacts of the module.
 - Avoid looking directly into active fiber ports, even if the module is Class 1 laser safe .
 - Disconnect the power adapter before removing the module to prevent electrical damage.
 - Regularly clean fiber connectors with approved cleaners to maintain signal quality .
- Following these steps ensures a safe, reliable, and efficient connection of the power adapter to your optical module while protecting both the hardware and personnel.
