Network racks contain multiple mounting slots, often called bays, each designed to hold a hardware unit secured with screws. As a core infrastructure component in data centers and telecom rooms, it houses critical devices such as servers, routers, and switches, enabling secure deployment and. A server rack is a metal frame that holds and organizes your IT equipment—like servers, switches, and power supplies—all in one place. It keeps things tidy, improves airflow, and makes it easier to manage and troubleshoot your setup. There are different types of server racks. Server racks adhere to the EIA-310-D standard, which specifies a 19-inch width for mounting equipment. Height is measured in 'Rack Units' (U), where 1U equals 1. Rack servers—also called rack-mounted servers—offer a compact, stackable solution for consolidating hardware while minimizing floor space.
