

Optical Cable Operation and Maintenance Management Procedures

Installation and Initial Setup

Proper installation is the foundation of optical cable reliability. Select the appropriate fiber type (single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for shorter runs) and compatible connectors (LC, SC, MTP/MPO) based on network requirements and environmental conditions . Maintain the minimum bend radius, avoid excessive pulling or twisting, and ensure connectors are clean before deployment . Environmental Control

Clean connectors using alcohol-free dry cleaning pens, lens tissue, or specialized fiber cleaning kits, and immediately cover cleaned ends to prevent re-contamination . Avoid bending cables or touching optical surfaces with bare hands .

Preventive Maintenance

Preventive maintenance reduces failures and extends cable lifespan. Monitor for insertion loss, signal reflection, and link instability using tools like OTDR (Optical Time Domain Reflectometer) and visual fault locators . Maintain logs of inspections, cleaning routines, and detected faults to support condition-based maintenance rather than fixed schedules . Replace aging or damaged cables promptly, especially if optical loss increases or connectors show visible wear .

Lifecycle Management

Optical cable lifecycle management includes selection, installation, usage, maintenance, and replacement . Evaluate environmental exposure, usage frequency, and performance metrics to determine replacement timing. Upgrade legacy cables (e.g., OM2 multimode) to modern high-performance fibers (OM4, OM5, OS2) to meet current and future bandwidth demands . Follow ITU-T L.25 recommendations for standardized maintenance procedures and compliance with global best practices .

Safety Considerations

Always follow safety protocols: avoid direct eye exposure to fiber light sources, handle optical modules in ESD-safe areas, and use protective gear when cleaning or inspecting fibers . Use clean dry air (CDA) for dust removal and ensure chemicals or cleaning solutions comply with manufacturer guidelines .
