1. Rated Current (Amperage): Circuit breakers are rated according to the maximum current they can safely carry without tripping. Typical household ratings include:

- Lighting circuits: 10A
 - Bedroom air conditioners: 16–20A
 - Living room or larger AC units: 25A
 - Kitchen sockets and high-power appliances: 30–32A
 - General-purpose sockets: 20A These ratings are chosen based on the connected load and wire size to prevent overheating and fire hazards .
2. Pole Configuration:

- 1P (Single-Pole) Breakers: Control only the live (phase) wire, commonly used in single-phase circuits. Neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar .
 - 2P (Double-Pole) Breakers: Control both live and neutral wires simultaneously, providing full isolation and enhanced safety, especially for circuits requiring complete disconnection .
3. Protection Type:
- MCB (Miniature Circuit Breaker): Protects against overcurrent and short circuits.
 - RCD/RCB (Residual Current Device): Detects leakage currents to prevent electric shock.
 - RCBO (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent): Combines overcurrent and leakage protection in one device .
4. Wiring and Connection:
- Live (L) Wire: Connects to the breaker's line terminal.
 - Neutral (N) Wire: For 1P breakers, connects directly to the neutral busbar; for 2P breakers, connects to the breaker's neutral terminal.
 - Protective Earth (PE): Connected to the breaker's dedicated terminal if residual current protection is present, then linked to the ground busbar .
5. Short-Circuit Capacity: Breakers must be rated to withstand the maximum prospective short-circuit current of the household supply to avoid damage during faults .
6. Distribution Box Considerations:
- Number of outgoing circuits should include spare ways for future expansion.
 - Proper internal layout with busbars, neutral and earth bars, and DIN rail space ensures safe and organized wiring .
 - Compliance with local standards (IEC, NEC, BS 7671) is essential for safety and legal requirements .
- Practical Selection Tips
- Match breaker rating to the wire size and appliance load.
 - Use 1P breakers for standard single-phase circuits and 2P for circuits requiring full isolation.
 - Include RCDs or RCBOs for circuits with high risk of leakage or in wet areas like kitchens and bathrooms.
 - Ensure the distribution box has adequate space for all breakers and future expansion . By carefully considering these parameters, household electrical systems can achieve safe, reliable, and code-compliant protection for all circuits.
