If the light is off, the port may not be providing power, possibly due to a non-PoE device, a faulty cable, or exceeding the port's power budget .

- **Stacking LEDs:** In stackable switches, green LEDs can also indicate active stack members and full bandwidth operation .
- **Troubleshooting:** If a green light is present but devices are not functioning, check the Ethernet cable, port configuration, and ensure the connected device supports PoE .
