- Single-mode fiber (SMF): \$0.10–\$0.50 per foot for standard indoor/outdoor cables; ideal for long-distance transmission up to 40–100 km without amplification .
- Multimode fiber (MMF): \$0.30–\$1.00 per foot, with OM3/OM4 standards common for data centers and LANs; supports shorter distances but lower-cost transceivers .
