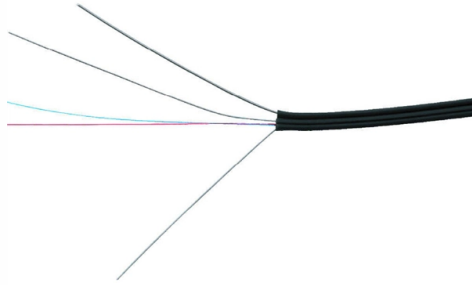


Separate power supply for the distribution box

Implementation in Multi-Story Buildings



In multi-story buildings, a common approach is to install a separate energy meter for each floor. The supply from each meter is routed to the floor's distribution box through a main switch and main fuse. From there, sub-circuits are drawn to branch circuits for lighting, sockets, and appliances. This method allows balanced load distribution and easier fault isolation . Alternatively, a single main meter can feed a central distribution board, which then supplies sub-distribution boxes on each floor, but this may reduce flexibility in isolating faults or managing loads .

Technical Considerations

- **Main Switch and Circuit Breakers:** Each distribution box should have a main switch rated for the maximum current and individual circuit breakers for protection against overloads and short circuits .
- **Busbars and Wiring:** Proper busbars and internal wiring ensure reliable power distribution from the separate supply to all circuits within the box .
- **Grounding and Neutral Connections:** Each box must have proper grounding and neutral bars to maintain safety and prevent electrical hazards .
- **Future Expansion:** It is recommended to retain 10-20% capacity in each distribution box to accommodate future load increases .

Applications

- **Residential:** Separate supplies can be used for different floors or high-demand appliances to prevent overloading a single circuit .
- **Commercial/Industrial:** Independent supplies allow critical equipment to remain operational even if other circuits fail, and facilitate energy monitoring and management .
