Single-mode fiber patch cords typically have a yellow jacket, with blue connectors for UPC and green connectors for APC terminations. Fiber Jacket Colors

- Yellow: Indicates single-mode fiber (OS1 or OS2), designed for long-distance, high-speed transmission using laser light sources .
- Other colors: Multimode fibers use different colors such as aqua for OM3, magenta for OM4, beige for OM1/OM2, and orange for 62.5/125 multimode fibers .

Connector Colors

- Blue: Single-mode UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) connectors, polished flat, suitable for standard single-mode connections .
- Green: Single-mode APC (Angled Physical Contact) connectors, polished at an 8-degree angle to reduce return loss. APC connectors must never be plugged into UPC ports to avoid damage .
- Beige: Multimode 62.5/125 fiber connectors.
- Aqua: Laser-optimized 50/125 multimode fiber connectors (OM3).

- Magenta: Laser-optimized 50/125 multimode fiber connectors (OM4), .
- Individual Fiber Strand Colors

For multi-fiber cables, the TIA-598-C standard defines a 12-color sequence for identifying individual fibers within a cable:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Slate (Gray)
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet
- Rose (Pink)
- Aqua For cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats, often with a contrasting stripe or tube color to differentiate groups of fibers .

Summary

- Jacket color: Yellow for single-mode fiber.
- Connector color: Blue for UPC, Green for APC.
- Individual fiber strands: Follow the TIA-598-C 12-color sequence for identification in multi-fiber cables. Using this color chart ensures proper identification, prevents mode or polish mismatches, and helps maintain network performance and safety during installation and maintenance .
