A secondary distribution box, or subpanel, allows you to safely extend electrical circuits from your main panel to new areas or high-demand loads. Purpose of a Subpanel

A subpanel functions as a downstream power distribution point from your main electrical panel. It divides a single large circuit from the main panel into multiple smaller circuits closer to where power is needed. This is useful for adding high-demand appliances, powering distant structures, or expanding your home's electrical capacity without upgrading the main service .

Planning and Location

- Placement: Choose a location near the intended load while maintaining safety and accessibility. Avoid damp areas, excessive heat, or obstructed spaces .
- Clearances: NEC Article 110.26 requires at least 3 feet of clear working space in front of the panel, 30 inches wide, and extending from the floor to 6.5 feet .



- **Permits:** Check local building codes. A licensed inspector may be required to approve the installation, determine the appropriate amperage, and issue a permit .

Wiring and Connections

- **Feeder Cable:** Connect the subpanel to the main panel using a feeder cable with two hot wires (L1 & L2), a neutral wire, and a ground wire .

- **Breaker:** Install a two-pole breaker in the main panel to feed the subpanel.

- **Neutral and Ground:** In the subpanel, do not bond neutral to ground; the neutral bus is only needed for 120V circuits or GFCI outlets .

- **Circuit Distribution:** The subpanel allows you to add multiple branch circuits locally, reducing long runs of wiring back to the main panel .

Safety Considerations

- Always shut off power to the main panel before working.

- Use a licensed electrician if you are unsure about installation.

- Ensure the subpanel is rated for the intended load (commonly 60A, 100A, or 200A depending on your main panel capacity), .

- Avoid using multiple GFCI breakers on the same circuit to prevent nuisance tripping .
