  - **Splitter Modules:** In FTTH or FTTx networks, optical splitters (1:8, 1:16, etc.) can be integrated into the box to divide signals efficiently to multiple subscribers .
  - **Fiber Storage and Slack Management:** Dedicated areas store excess fiber length, ensuring organized routing and preventing fiber damage. These areas are often labeled for easy identification .
  - **Fixing Devices and Cable Entry Points:** The box includes cable clamps, grommets, or fixing devices to secure incoming and outgoing cables, providing strain relief and insulation between metal components and the enclosure .
  - **Doors and Closures:** Secure doors with latches or locks allow easy access for maintenance while preventing unauthorized entry and environmental exposure .
  - **Mounting Features:** Wall-mount or pole-mount options with slots or threaded holes enable secure installation in various network environments .
