In fiber optics, a red light source is commonly used for testing and troubleshooting. Devices like Visual Fault Locators (VFLs) emit a bright red laser (typically around 650 nm) into the fiber to identify breaks, bends, or damaged connectors. When the light travels through the fiber, any scattered light escaping at a damaged spot makes faults visible externally, allowing technicians to locate and repair issues efficiently. These devices can operate in continuous or flashing modes and are compatible with various fiber connectors such as SC, ST, FC, LC, and MU.

Red Light on Network Equipment

If the red light appears on an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or router, it often signals a loss of signal (LoS) or a serious fault in the fiber connection. For example, a red LoS light indicates that the device is not receiving light from the service provider, which could be due to a broken fiber, high attenuation, or a network outage. In this case, the red light is a warning rather than a testing indicator, and contacting your service provider is recommended.

Interpreting the Red Light

- During testing with a VFL: A lit red light is normal and indicates the fiber is being illuminated for fault detection. The light helps identify breaks or bends along the fiber path .
- On operational network equipment: A red light usually indicates a problem with the fiber connection, such as a break, misalignment, or signal loss. Both ends of the fiber should ideally show light if the connection is intact .

Recommended Actions

- If using a VFL or fiber tester: Proceed with the inspection to locate any faults. Ensure the fiber ends and connectors are clean for accurate results.
- If the red light is on an ONT or router: Report the issue to your service provider, as it may indicate a network fault beyond your premises. Avoid attempting to reset the device repeatedly, as this will not resolve a true fiber break . In summary, a lit red light can either be a normal testing signal or a fault indicator. Understanding the context—whether it is a testing device or network equipment—is key to interpreting its meaning correctly.
