The Tuvalu Vaka Cable is a 688 km submarine fiber optic system connecting Funafuti, the capital of Tuvalu, to the trunk of Google's Bulikula cable system, as part of the Pacific Connect initiative . This project marks Tuvalu's first-ever international subsea cable, transitioning the nation from satellite-dependent connectivity to a high-capacity, permanent fiber optic network . The cable contains four fiber pairs and is designed to support faster, more reliable, and affordable internet access across the country .

Equipment and Technical Partners



The cable system was supplied by SubCom, a leading submarine cable manufacturer . Technical implementation involved Google as a partner, alongside CIENA and local contractors, ensuring the integration of modern fiber optic transmission equipment and network management systems . The cable connects to Tuvalu's terrestrial network through fiber access terminals, enabling distribution to public and private sector services . Integration into the Central Pacific Cable (CPC) network provides diversified routing through multiple Points of Presence (PoPs), enhancing network resilience and continuity .

Funding and Project Support

The Vaka Cable project cost approximately USD 56 million (AUD 80 million) and was fully grant-funded by the United States, Australia, New Zealand, and Taiwan, with Australia contributing up to USD 37 million through the Australian Infrastructure Financing Facility for the Pacific (AIFFP), . The project also received support from Japan and other regional partners .

Operational and Environmental Considerations

The cable is expected to be fully operational by Q3 2026 . During construction, proactive measures were taken to mitigate environmental risks, including elevated landing platforms to address rising sea levels and the use of solar-powered equipment to reduce reliance on diesel . Rainwater harvesting and other sustainability measures were also incorporated into the project design .

Impact on Tuvalu

The Vaka Cable significantly enhances Tuvalu's digital capacity, enabling improved access to education, healthcare, and economic opportunities . It supports regional digital market participation, strengthens public services, and provides a platform for cultural preservation and global connectivity . The integration into the CPC network ensures long-term network resilience and diversified international routing .
