Cable Management Components Cable guides, clamps, and routing channels ensure strain relief, proper bend radius, and organized fiber layout, reducing the risk of signal degradation and facilitating network expansion . 4. Dust Covers and Environmental Protection Dust covers, IP65/IP68-rated enclosures, and weatherproof materials protect fibers from dust, moisture, and physical damage, making boxes suitable for indoor and outdoor installations . 5. Identification and Labeling Accessories Labels, tags, and color-coded components help in network management, troubleshooting, and scalability, ensuring that fibers are easily traceable and organized .
