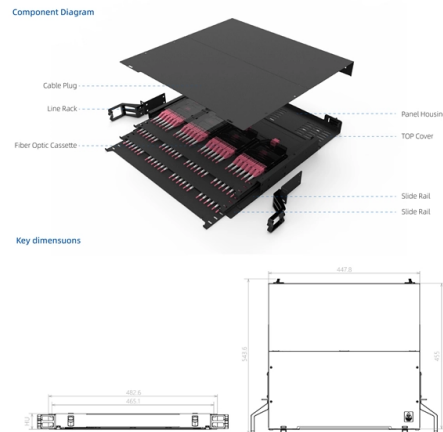

Unlike T-junction boxes (which distribute power to multiple cable branches) or power junction boxes (which connect the system to the main power supply), the terminal box does not distribute power. Its sole purpose is to seal and protect the cable end, making it a critical component for maintaining the integrity of the heat tracing system .
