Installation and Safety Considerations

Cables in trays must be properly secured and not overfilled, as overloading can compromise structural integrity and create hazards such as electric shock or arc-flash events . The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies allowable fill percentages, typically 40-50% of the tray's cross-sectional area, depending on cable type, voltage, and ampacity . Supports, fittings, and covers are used to maintain spacing, protect cables, and navigate changes in direction or elevation .
