- Connecting Fiber to Routers

The fiber cable plugs into the ONT, which converts light signals into electrical signals that the router can process. The router then distributes the internet connection via Ethernet or Wi-Fi to devices . Routers designed for fiber connections may include SFP or WAN ports specifically labeled for fiber input .
