Main functions of cable trays include: Mechanical support – carry the weight of cables and protect them from excessive sagging or mechanical stress. Organization and routing – provide clear routes for power, control, and data cables and simplify cable management. 1993 NEC Section 300-7 (b) states that “Raceways shall be provided with expansion joints where necessary to compensate for the thermal expansion or. Cable tray systems provide a safe, organized, and flexible method for supporting insulated conductors and cables in commercial and industrial electrical installations. Because of its closed design, this type of tray should be used in applications where there is minimal risk of heat generation and buildup.
